

What is SOZO?

Sozo is originally a Greek word meaning “to save or make well or whole”. It is used 110 times in the New Testament. According to the Strong’s Greek Dictionary of the New Testament, Sozo also means “to save, deliver, heal, and preserve”.

- **Salvation** – “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save (sozo) that which was lost”. Luke 19:10.
- **Salvation** – “That is you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead you shall be saved (sozo)” . Romans 10:9.
- **Healing** – “But Jesus turning and seeing her said, “Daughter, take courage, your faith has made you well (sozo), and at once the woman was made well (sozo)”. Matthew 9:22
- **Deliverance** – “And those who had seen it reported to them how the man who was demon-possessed had been made well (sozo)”. Luke 8:36.

SOZO ministry is a first commandment tool used for inner healing and prophetic deliverance based on (1) anointed Forgiveness and (2) embracing Truth which:

- Gets to the root of issues that hinder our love for God
- Gets rid of lies we believed that block us from knowing His love
- Replaces the lies with truth and revelation
- And connects your heart to the 3 Persons in the Godhead

The purpose of Sozo is to strengthen one’s relationship with the God-Head, and *to connect people to the Godhead, (the Father, the Holy Spirit, and to Jesus) in a more intimate way so they can fully walk out in identity and fulfill their destiny.*

Paul prayed for the Ephesians that they would *know* for themselves how high and deep and wide His love for them really is....Ephesians 3:17. Jesus says “You shall *know* the truth and the truth shall make you free,” John 8:32. The Greek word for “know” means to have an intimate and personal encounter.

Prior to your Sozo Session...

Pray

- For the Holy Spirit to break any areas of unbelief or strongholds in your life.
- For the Truth to be established in your innermost being.
- For greater intimacy with the Godhead.

Fast. Ask the Lord what He wants you to fast (fast food, an activity, media, etc.)
